



This story belongs to Antgad Sootra (Aagam)






One day while Skandashri was on her way to worship Yaksha, she was teased by 6 men who said, "Who is this beautiful lady? Let us take her away.

The aim of the game is to find out who gets to follow Jainism at the earliest, who is the luckiest of all.




- Maximum 4 players
- To begin with, all the members will have to throw the dice once.
- One who gets maximum number on the dice will go in Manushya gati (Yellow counter) and the others will go in Dev gati(Blue counter), Tiryanch gati(Green counter) and Narak gati(Red counter) respectively.
- These four gatis will be their starting point and their end point is in the centre i.e., Jain religion. After taking their positions, Manushya gati player will start first and throw the dice.
- All the players will move along the boxes according to the numbers on the dice.
- If another player comes in your box from behind, then you will have to restart again. The one who came from behind will continue.
- No body can beat that player who comes in a box with positive zone. This is because the positive zone carries lots of positive energy. It has either Uvvasaggaharam Stotra or Namaskar Mantra or Tirthankar Keval Gyan or Guru Vandan written on it. Thus any number of players can stand in this box and still be safe.
- One who enters the middle box earliest is the winner. He/She gets to follow Jainism first and the one who enters the box last, is the loser.




